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## Independent examiner's report to the PCC of St Mary's Nantwich.

I report on the accounts of the PCC for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018, which are set out on pages 03 to 10.

### Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The members of the PCC are responsible for the preparation of the accounts. The PCC consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144(2) of the Charities Act 2011 (the 2011 Act) and that an independent examination is needed.

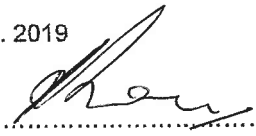

### 1. Accounting Policies

1a. The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Charities Act 2011 and Church Accounting Regulations 2006 together with applicable accounting standards and Charities Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP 2005). In previous years the PCC accounts have been prepared on an accruals basis. These Accounts are prepared on the same basis. This means that the cost of goods and services is accounted for in the year they were supplied even if payment was not made until the following year.

1b. We are required to produce a balance sheet which includes the value of fixed assets; any assets that are considered to have a limited useful life will be depreciated. It is not considered necessary to depreciate any fixed assets this year. Consecrated and beneficed property is excluded from the accounts under the Charities Act 2011. The purchase of nearly all other assets have, in the past effectively been written off in the year of purchase. The exception is the Curates House which was valued at cost.

### 10. Mortgage on Curate's House

The mortgage on No:22 Beatty Road, Nantwich was arranged with the Church Commissioners via the Diocese. It is an interest only mortgage. No capital is repayable until the house is sold. Capital repayment to the Commissioners would be in the same proportion as the original mortgage to purchase price. The House was sold in July 2018 for £229,000 resulting in £80,921 accruing to the PCC. We intend to buy a new curates house early in 2019.

**13. Notes on Funds**

**Restricted**

**13(a). The Bourne Fund.**

This fund was established by a local family to provide flowers for the Church where appropriate.

**13(b). The Curate's House Fund.**

This fund is established to provide for the maintenance and decoration of the house. Currently it holds the proceeds of sale of the Curates House at 22 Beatty Road, in July 2018. These funds will be used as a deposit on a new Curates House in early 2019.

**13(c). The Restoration and Development Fund (R&D Fund)**

The PCC have determined the R&D Fund should maintain a minimum balance of £20,000 to cover emergencies.

Held within the fund is the balance of the Moira Blakemore Legacy of £10,748. This will eventually be used to fund replacement Muniment Boards dedicated to her memory.

**13(d). The Visitor's Centre Fund.**

This activity was originally started to generate funds for the above R&D Fund. This is done by operating the Church Shop and providing refreshments for visitors. This fund will be used to finance the creation of a Visitor Centre including a small shop in the Church hopefully in 2019 or 2020, funds permitting.

**13(e). The Education Fund**

This fund originated from the sale, by the Diocese, of the Church of England School in the town. The Diocese allocated a small part of the sale price to the Church, the capital of which is held to generate income to be used for educational purposes. All the accumulated income has been used in 2016 and 2017 to support early year's education for Church children's groups.

**13(f). The Lyon Restoration Fund**

This fund resulted from a bequest of Mr Ben Lyon, a local business man. As its name indicates the income is to be used for the purpose of restoration of the Church. Some years ago the PCC decided the income should be transferred, as it accrues, to the Nantwich Parish Church Preservation Appeal Trust (see 13j overleaf).

**Unrestricted**

**13(g). The Summer Concert Fund (previously the Piano Fund)**

This fund was originally established to generate funds for the purchase of a grand piano for use in the Church. The acquisition was made in 2016. In 2017 the fund was used to provide enhanced lighting for the Choir.

**13(h). Friday Soup Lunch Fund**

The provision of a soup and a sandwich to the needy in Nantwich up to early 2017 was undertaken by Churches Together in Nantwich (NTiC). When NTiC withdrew, the Church picked up the baton in 2017. This fund has been set up to receive income and make payments independent of the General Fund.

**Endowments**

The Church has no endowment funds.

**Funds not under the control of the PCC**

**13(i). The Church House, Nantwich.**

Reg No 1177087

This a charity charged with the care of the building known both as Church House and the Parish Hall. The trustees manage the building and associated assets for the benefit of St Mary's Church, Nantwich and the wider community. The Charity had excepted status but in February 2018 registered with the Charity Commission.

**13(j). The Nantwich Parish Church Preservation Appeal Trust.** Reg No: 507911

The object of this charity is the raising and administering of funds for the preservation, restoration and repair of the fabric of St Mary's Parish Church Nantwich Cheshire.
